High school bowling team results

Sophomore Alicia Harbin has been on fire this season leading the girls' varsity team. Harbin's 258-203 (461 series) Monday, Jan. 3, earned her both match points.

Senior Kaylla Koster bowled well with a 206-196 (402 series) and won one point. Senior Shannon Kelley returned to the lineup from an injury and won a match point with a 182 game. Senior Kelsey Ruebelmann won both of her match points with 138 and 136 games.

Sophomores Stephanie Seefried and Kaitlin Lowran both worked hard throughout the close match, however, Ike was able to prevail as the girls' team lost the first baker game by only two pins. Those two pins made all the difference in the match in the end, as Romeo was bested 17-13.

The boys' varsity team bowled very well and were led by junior Matthew Fazzalare's 244-234 (478 series) but were outscored by Ike in the bakers and lost 20 1/2 to 9 1/2.

Freshman Dylan Stokes won both of his match points with 215-219 (434 series). Freshman Tyler Culver won a match point with his 229 game and 412 series. Senior Tyler Stokes won a point with a 195 game and junior Alec Shipman won a point with a 191 game. Fazzalare tied his opponent with his 244 game for 1/2 a point. Fazzalare deserved better, but his opponent put up a 244-255 (499 series) against him. Romeo lost both bakers as Ike was hot and shot 263-221 (481 series).

Romeo kept it close until the eighth frame of the first game and ended up with a 222 game. The team adjusted well from adversity for the regular match games and shot 1,008-1,055 (2,063 series) to Ike's 1,048-1,024 (2,072 series).

It was a very exciting match and the young Romeo team made a great run near the end winning the last game and nearly taking totals.

The junior varsity boys lost a squeaker and were led by freshman Patrick Brunkey's 166-211 (377 series). Ike won both baker games and barely held on to win the match 17-13.

The junior varsity boys lost the first match game 834-827 and that turned out to be the difference in the match as they came back to dominate the second match game and win totals 877-815. Brunkey won both of his match points and fellow freshman Joseph Seefried also won both of his match points with 182-193 (375 series).

Sophomores Kirk Lightcap's 176-176 (352 series) and Michael Steffens' 180-157 (337 series) won both of their match points. Sophomore Andrew Nelson battled his opponent but was not able to win any match points.
